How do small businesses fit in: niches, operations, marketing, distribution? How does your business fit into industry; history, profitability, growth patterns? Scale & differentiation?	
Target Market(s). List the markets you intend to reach and why you chose them; support with market analysis or market research.	
Products and Services: List products or services you offer	
<b>Marketing and Sales Strategy:</b> Describe yow you intend to reach your target market(s): advertising, direct mail, trade shows, etc.	

Competitors & Market Distribution: Major competitors, where strong, where weak.
Competitive Advantages: Why your company will be able to compete successfully; list advantages patents, major contracts, or letters-of-intent. How will you defend your position?
Management: Briefly describe the histories and capabilities of your management team, & company founders & plan to add expertise to management team.
Operations: Outline your key operational features, such as locations, crucial distributors or suppliers, cost-saving production techniques, etc.
<b>Financials</b> : 3 years historical financials, 3 years projections, compare both to industry averages. Goals and objectives turned into numbers.
<b>Long-term Goals:</b> Describe the expected status, e.g., sales, number of employees, number of locations, market share of your company five years from now.
Funds Sought and Exit Strategy: How much money from loans or investors vs. your personal investment; how will be used, how investor/lender will be paid back.
