EMERGENCY ORDER (2020-9) FOR CONTROL OF PANDEMIC Required monitoring at Childcare Centers

This Order is made pursuant to Section 2453 of the Public Health Code, being MCL 333.2453.

Matters concerning the public health of the residents of Oakland County have been brought to the attention of the Oakland County Local Health Officer. The Local Health Officer has determined that controls are necessary to reduce transmission of COVID-19 to protect the public's health of Oakland County based on the following facts:

- 1. A biological agent or the effects of a biological agent have been detected within Oakland County
- 2. A communicable disease **Coronavirus which causes COVID-19** has been identified that can be transmitted from person to person.
- 3. In order to control and limit the spread of the communicable disease, it is necessary to prevent infected people from coming into contact with uninfected people.

It is hereby ordered that:

- 1. All Childcare Centers develop and implement a daily screening program for all staff, children, parents, and visitors. Restrict all non-essential visitors from the daycare.
- 2. The screening criteria must include the following:
 - a. Screening criteria must include the following questions:
 - Symptoms including but not limited to: fever, cough (excluding cough due to known chronic cough), shortness of breath, sore throat, and/or diarrhea (excluding diarrhea due to known medical reason).
 - b. Close contact in the last 14 days with someone with a confirmed diagnosis of COVID-19.
 - c. Travel internationally or domestically in the last 14 days.
 - d. Procedures must be in place to take the temperature of all covered individuals.
- 3. A yes to any of the screening questions above requires the employee to be excluded:
 - At least 72 hours with no fever (that is three full days of no fever without use of medicine that reduces fevers) AND other symptoms have improved (for example, when your cough and shortness of breath have improved)
 AND at least 7 days have passed since your symptoms first appeared
 - ii. 14 days if close contact of diagnosed case of COVID-19
 - iii. 14 days following travel

- 4. The contents of this Order shall be published at entrance of the facility and to the members of the public at large by all reasonable means available.
- 5. The contents of this Order shall be published to the members of the public at large by all reasonable means available.

This Order shall become effective **immediately** and continue until rescinded.
