An individual who organizes and operates a business, undertaking the financial risks associated with creating, organizing and owning the business.



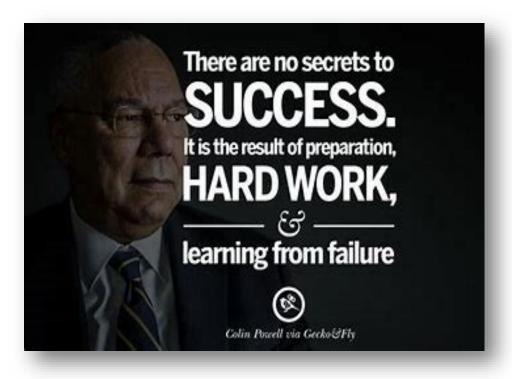

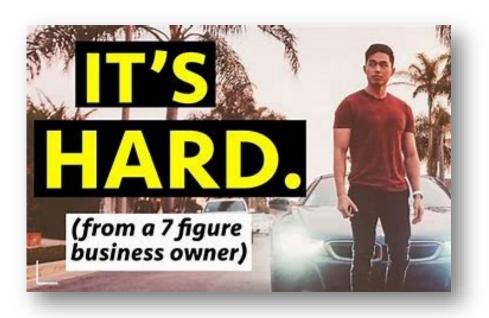

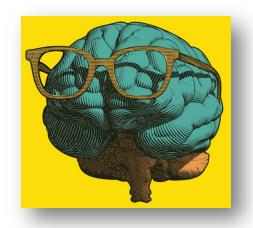

- Study Demographics



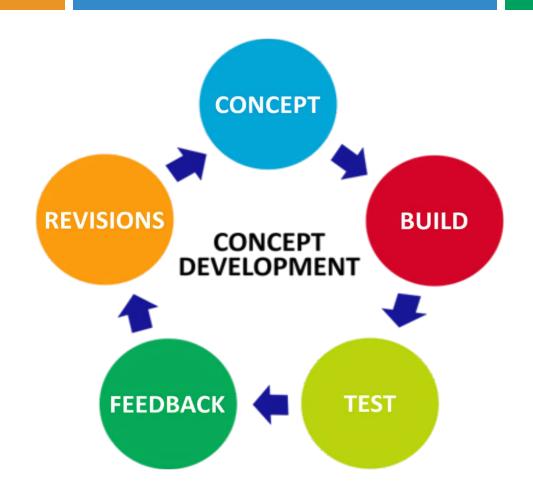
Market Research

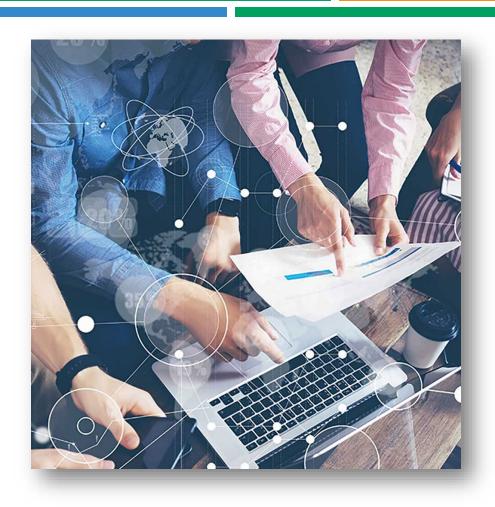
