

VISITOR AND VENDOR SCREENING CHECKLIST FOR SCHOOLS

CORONAVIRUS
COVID-19

This checklist provides basic information only. It is not intended to take the place of medical advice, diagnosis or treatment.

SCREENING QUESTIONS AND HOW TO RESPOND

1. Are you currently experiencing ONE or more of the following symptoms unrelated to a known pre-existing condition (e.g. asthma, allergies)?

- ☐ New cough ☐ Shortness of breath ☐ Difficulty breathing ☐ New loss of taste or smell
- ☐ No I am not experiencing one or more of the above symptoms.

If you are experiencing one or more of the above symptoms, stay home, consult your medical provider, and get tested for COVID-19.

2. Are you currently experiencing any TWO of the following symptoms unrelated to a known pre-existing condition (e.g. asthma, allergies)?

- ☐ Fever (100.4 degrees or greater) ☐ Chills (rigors) ☐ Diarrhea (2x in 24 hours) ☐ Congestion or runny nose
- ☐ Nausea or vomiting (2x in 24 hours) ☐ Headache ☐ Muscle aches (myalgias) ☐ Sore throat
- ☐ Fatigue ☐ No I am not experiencing two or more of the above symptoms.

If you are experiencing two or more of the above symptoms, stay home, consult your medical provider, and get tested for COVID-19.

If experiencing only one of these symptoms, stay home and consult your medical provider. You may return to work/school after being fever free for 24 hours without taking fever reducing medication and symptoms have improved.

3. Have you had close contact (within 6 ft for 15 minutes or greater) with anyone (including household members) who had a positive COVID-19 diagnostic test in the past 14 days?

- ☐ Yes ☐ No

If yes to question 3, unvaccinated individuals should quarantine for 5 days from last exposure; fully vaccinated individuals do not need to quarantine but are recommended to get a COVID-19 test 5 days after exposure.

If you answer NO to all the above questions, you have passed the screening and can begin working and/or attend school.

4. Have you traveled internationally within the last 14 days?

- ☐ Yes ☐ No

If yes to question 4, CDC recommends all travelers get a COVID-19 test 3-5 days after travel, self monitor for symptoms, and get tested if symptoms develop. If you are not fully vaccinated, quarantine for a full 7 days after travel even if you get a COVID-19 test. If you do not get tested, quarantine for 10 days after travel.
