Along with volunteer duties, Sheriff Cadet I's are exposed to professional law enforcement training in various fields including, but not limited to: Corrective Services, Patrol Services, Dispatch, Court Services, Forensic Services, and Friend of the Court. Sheriff Cadet I's will have the opportunity to shadow experienced sheriff's office employees in their specific work area. These basic duties that Sheriff Cadet I's perform serve to offer practical experience and broad exposure to the Oakland County Sheriff's Office, and provide an applicant pool of experienced and exposed individuals for entry level sheriff's office positions.

### **Minimum Requirements:**

- Be at least 16 years of age and no older than 21.
- Are working toward a high school diploma or GED, or are in post high school education.
- Successfully pass sheriff's office background investigation and application process.
- Successfully pass two-month probationary period.
- Successfully pass a Sheriff Cadet Academy, administered through Oakland County.
