ELIGIBILITY FOR EARLY DISCHARGE FROM PROBATION

Procedure and Requirements:

- 1. You may request early discharge from probation by filing a Notice of Eligibility for Early Discharge from Probation (MC 512) once you have successfully completed one half of the original probationary term ordered by the Judge.
- 2. You must serve a copy of the Notice of Eligibility for Early Discharge from Probation on the prosecutor and the probation department. A proof of service must be filed with the court.
- 3. The court may deny your request if you do not serve the necessary parties and file the proper documents.
- 4. The court will not consider early discharge unless all probation requirements have been completed and at least three consecutive months have passed with no probation violations.
- 5. You may have a lawyer represent you at the hearing. However, you do not have the right to a court-appointed attorney.
- 6. If you are on probation for Domestic Violence, you are not eligible for early release from probation.
- 7. Early discharge from probation does not relieve you of your court-ordered financial obligations.

 - a listed offense as defined in section 2 of the Sex Offenders Registration Act, MCL 28.722
 - an offense for which a defense was asserted under section 36 of chapter VIII (MCL 768.36)
 - a violation of MCL 750.462a to 750.462h, or former section 462i or 462j of that act
