OAKLAND COUNTY PROBATE COURT Notice to Delinquent and Suspended Fiduciaries Pursuant to MCR 5.203

Delinguent

If you have received a *Notice of Deficiency* (PC 600), you have failed to comply with some fiduciary duty. You are considered "delinquent." The checked boxes on the *Notice* tell you what you have to file or do.

- You have 28 days from the date of the *Notice* to comply.
- If you do not file or do what you are supposed to within 28 days of the <u>Notice</u>, the court will automatically give you one 28 day extension. It is best to take care of the deficiency as soon as possible.
- If you can not take care of the deficiency within the combined 56 day period, you may need a second 28-day extension. You must request it in writing using OCPC Form 1063 <u>Request for Extension</u> <u>of Time for Compliance.</u>

Suspended

If you still do not file or do what you are supposed to, the court **will suspend** you. If that happens, you will lose your powers as fiduciary until you do everything listed here and you are reinstated by the court.

- You must comply with the **Notice of Deficiency** requirements.
- You must also file a <u>Petition for Reinstatement</u> (PC 603). It will be set for hearing unless <u>Waiver/Consents</u> (PC 561) from all interested persons are presented prior to the hearing.
- All necessary filing fees must be submitted with the delinquent documents and the *Petition for Reinstatement*.
