Do you use SNAP/EBT Benefits?

Oakland County Food Policy Council has gathered a list of food assistance programs, and additional programs, services, and discounts you and/or your household may be eligible for simply because you have SNAP (EBT, Bridge Card) benefits. Food Assistance and Programs	
Food and Other Resources (F.O.R) Helpline Phone: 1-888-544-8773	Helps with finding a food pantry, applying for SNAP benefits, or other resources.
WIC (Women, Infants & Children) Special Supplemental Nutrition Program Phone: 248-858-1272	Provides supplemental healthy food, nutrition counseling, and other services. Call to determine eligibility or make an appointment.
Project Fresh Phone: 248-858-1272	Provides a \$25 coupon booklet for enrolled WIC clients to spend on fresh fruits and vegetables at farmers markets or stands from June-October. Call to enroll.
Double Up Food Bucks (DUFB) Phone: 866-586-2796	DUFB matches your fruit and vegetable purchases when you use your SNAP/EBT card. Receive up to \$10/per day. Find a DUFB location.

Affordable Connectivity Phone: 877-384-2575	Federal program to help households connect with broadband internet. Up to a \$30/month discount on internet service. Households can also receive a one-time discount to purchase laptop, desktop or tablet computer (up to \$100). Only one month service discount and one device discount allowed per household.
Comcast (Xfinity) Internet	Discounted service for eligible households (\$9.95-\$29.95/month). Eligible households: SNAP, Medicaid, SSI, Housing Assistance, and National School Lunch Program participation.
AT&T Internet Phone: 800-288-2020 (existing service), 899-861-6075 (new service)	Discounted service for eligible households (\$30/month or less). Eligible households: SNAP and National School Lunch Program participation.
WOW Way Phone: 866-496-9669	Service credit up to \$30/month. Participates in the Affordable Connectivity Program.
Amazon Prime Membership	Discounted membership at \$6.99/month. Benefits include groceries, 2-day shipping services and streaming services. Eligible households include SNAP, WIC, and TANF.
Lifeline Phone: 800-234-9473	A federal program that helps eligible customers lower the internet and/or phone service. Eligible households include SNAP, Medicaid, Housing Assistance, or depending on income.
Clear Captions Phone: 866-868-8695	A free federal service for qualifying individuals to provide phone (home/mobile) products with conversation captioning services.
