Kowall to serve second three-year term on MAC Board

October 7, 2021, OAKLAND COUNTY, MI. – During the Board of Directors meeting, held at Michigan Counties Annual Conference Sept. 26-28, Commissioner **Eileen T. Kowall** (R-White Lake Twp.) was elected to serve as second vice president of the Michigan Association of Counties (MAC) Board.
