REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

1. ID for all household members 18 and over.
2. Proof of household income for the last 30 days or categorical eligibility document.
3. Social Security Card.
4. Water Bill

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Must be a Residential Account.
- Must be in Arrears or Disconnect Status.
- Must be under 200% Federal Poverty Level or receive
 - » Temporary Assistance for Needy Family
 - » Food Assistance Program/ Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program
 - » State Emergency Relief (SER)
 - » Social Security Income
 - » Weatherization Assistance
