Welcome to Groveland Oaks Campground

2022 Camping Season: April 29 - Oct. 3

Groveland Oaks County Park is located on Stewart Lake. It offers a beautiful sandy beach, three children’s playscapes, a fishing pier and a 2-mile paved and grass trail. A bike skills course, GaGa ball pit; miniature golf; skateboard park; an arcade; basketball and sand volleyball courts are also available to campers and park visitors.

The campground features 267 campsites; 12 group camping areas; 2-, 4- and 6-person cabins; and 6-person yurts including two on Cottage Island.

All sites have water and electric with full sewer hookup on sites 1 - 112

Cabins & Yurts Amenities

Amenities include:

- 2-person cabin features one queen-sized bed
- 4-person cabins feature two twin-sized bunk beds
- 6-person cabins and yurts feature two twin-sized bunk beds, one queen-sized bed and air conditioning/heating unit
- Fee includes parking for two vehicles

All cabins and yurts include

Small refrigerator, table and chairs, small microwave, electricity, water nearby, outdoor cooking grill, picnic table and fire pit.

- Guest must provide own linens, cooking utensils, related supplies
- Except for service animals, no animals are allowed in or to remain overnight outside of, cabins or yurts
- Smoking is not permitted inside cabins or yurts Gas/ portable heaters are not allowed
- No tents are allowed at cabin or yurt sites

A \$50 deposit on a credit card is required at check-in. If no damage is done, the \$50 deposit will be returned at time of departure after inspection has been completed.

Adjustments for the 2022 Season due to COVID-19

- Park amenities are subject to modifications and closures based on most current State and Federal guidelines and staff availability.
- Only staff will be permitted inside the contact station building. Walk-up service is available at the service window located under the yellow awning

COVID-19 Cleaning Procedures

- Restrooms will be cleaned and sanitized multiple times daily. Be advised there will be periodic closures while they are being sanitized. Please do your part to help keep them clean.
- Please properly dispose of all cleaning supplies/ personal protective equipment (i.e. gloves, masks, disinfectant wipes, etc.) None of these items should be flushed down toilets, burned in fires or left on the ground.
- Please do not apply anything to the ground including fertilizers, pesticides, weed killer, bleach and disinfectants.

Cancellation policy for campsites, cabins and yurts:
If notice of cancellation is received 7 or more days prior to the beginning of the reservation, all charges will be refunded. If the notice of cancellation is received less than 7 days prior to the beginning of the reservation, the reserving person/entity forfeits one-half of the fees paid.

Friendly Reminders 248-634-9811

- Quiet hours are observed from 11 p.m.–7 a.m.
- Check out times:
 - o 1 p.m. – campsites, cabins, and yurts.
 - Renewals required before 1 p.m.; based on availability
- Site fee includes two vehicles. Maximum two vehicles allowed per site.
- The tongue of the camping trailer hitch must face the road.
- Maximum of two tents or one camper and one tent allowed on each site.
- Visitors are welcome from 8 a.m.–10 p.m. An annual or daily permit is required.
- Help keep the park clean by placing all trash in the proper receptacles. Dumpsters are located by the dump station, Section C restroom building, day use parking lot, behind the mini golf course and beside the concession restroom building. On-site trash pickup is not offered.
- Cats and dogs are welcome but must be kept indoors or on a six-foot leash. Animals may not be left unattended and are not allowed at or near cabins or yurts. Owners or caretakers must pick up all dog droppings.
- Clotheslines must be removed at sundown.
- Refrigerators and other large electrical appliances are not permitted outside of trailers.
- All grey/wastewater must be disposed of at the designated dump station(s) per the Oakland County Health Department Sanitary Code Section 4.1
- No hose splitters can be attached to any water spigot or hose per the Oakland County Health Department.
- Park visitors may not feed birds or other wildlife at any time. This includes bird feeders attached to or around RVs and trailers at campgrounds, regardless of whether they are attracting deer.
- Refer to the Oakland County Parks and Recreation General Information & Regulations booklet and Groveland Oaks Camper Guide for additional information.

Off-roading also is a family sport and we will be monitoring to ensure ORV users follow the rules:

- ORV trailers are allowed on the campsite if they fit on the camping pad
- Trailers that do not fit on the camping pad can be parked in the overflow parking area
- Only street licensed registered vehicles may operate on campground roads
- No testing or tuning will be allowed at campsites or anywhere in the park
- Vehicle limits are still 2 per campsite

Miscellaneous Tips

- The campground is mowed:
 - o Monday Sections D, E, F sites 113 – 267
 - o Tuesday Group areas and the activity field
 - o Wednesday Sections A, B sites 1 – 52
 - o Thursday Section C sites 53 – 112
 - o Remove lawn decorations, dog leash hooks, etc. to prevent damage.
 - o This schedule is based on weather and staff availability.
- Please do not cut or damage trees


