- V. OLD BUSINESS
 - a. LEPC Exercise subcommittee report
 - 1. HazMat TTX on 12/8/2022 discussion: Chair reported that preparations will not be complete in time to host this TTX, so it will be rescheduled for the first quarter of 2023.
 - b. LEPC Bylaws subcommittee report: Page reported that Committee still needs to meet to finalize proposed Bylaws before sending them to Oakland County Corp Counsel. Hopeful that there will be a full report by next meeting.
 - c. Spills report
 - 1. Wixom Hexavalent Chromium Spill: Page updated the group with a complete review of the 7/30/2022 incident. Of the original feared 8,000 pound release, EGLE now estimates that only 20 pounds made it into the local watershed. The vast majority of the remaining product was contained at the Tribar facility, and some was contained at the Wixom water treatment plant. Incident was ruled accidental, but caused by human error (a junior plant operator improperly discharged product from a holding tank, circumventing plant safety protocols). EGLE may take administrative action against Wixom water treatment plant, in addition to penalties against Tribar.
 - 2. Spills reported by MABAS 3210/3202 HazMat Teams: Page summarized four release/spills reported to OCEM by MABAS 3201 (gasoline spill at Mobil in White Lake on 10/31/2022 and Ace Cool spill at Midwest Glass Fabricators in Highland on 7/3/2022) and 3202 (diesel spill on Telegraph at E Quarton in Bloomfield Twp on 6/14/2022 and an unknown oily substance spilled at TCC Auto Center in Southfield on 4/22/2022) HazMat Teams:
 - d. Industry Outreach Conference: Page reported on the current status of the plan for the Conference. Four hours from 0800-1200hrs, with lunch to follow.
