

Cross-country skiing

Trails are groomed and rental equipment is available on weekends at Independence Oaks County Park. Get updated trail conditions by calling 248-625-0877.

Skiers with their own equipment can make tracks at Addison Oaks, Highland Oaks, Independence Oaks, Orion Oaks and Rose Oaks county parks.

Hiking and Snowshoeing

Miles of trails and open spaces at several Oakland County Parks locations welcome hikers and snowshoers.

Fat Tire Trails

Addison Oaks County Park features nearly six miles of groomed trails for winter biking enthusiasts. The route includes hills and scenic views as it winds through the park.



Sledding Hill

Riders whoosh down a 325-foot hill at Waterford Oaks County Park. Free entry. Bring your own sled. Open daily from dusk to dawn or as posted at the park. Portable restrooms on-site.



Platform Tennis

The sport, a cross between tennis and racquetball, is played outdoors on lighted courts October through mid-May at Waterford Oaks County Park. Reservations required. Membership application is posted at OaklandCountyParks.com. Call 248-645-9671 or 248-858-0916.



Nature Centers
