

STATE OF MICHIGAN "RECREATION PASSPORT"

Beginning Oct. 1, 2010, the State of Michigan began offering a Recreation Passport to replace its annual motor vehicle and boating access permits. The normal license plate sticker bears a special designation that indicates Recreation Passport status and allows entry to all State Park facilities.

The Recreation Passport designation DOES NOT allow entry to the Oakland County Parks or Huron-Clinton Metroparks.

Oakland County Parks and HCMA do not receive any funds from the state program.

What's the difference?




Oakland County Parks Annual Vehicle Permit

allows entry to eight of the 15 Oakland County Parks that require permits.



Parks Perks Pass

allows entry to the eight Oakland County Parks as well as 13 Metroparks.



State Recreation Passport allows entry to State Parks only.
Indicated by "P" on license plate tab.
