Oakland County residents of all ages are invited to honor the value of our precious water resources by participating in the organization's first ever photo contest. The goal of the contest is to promote this National Day of Action and encourage participants to think about how they value water. One winner will receive a \$100 Amazon gift card courtesy of Pure Oakland Water.

"I'm always impressed by the creativity of our community," said Nash. "The art of photography combined with social media is a great way to provide a fresh perspective on the value of water and will inspire us to think about how we use it. Our mission is to help our communities understand that our water infrastructure is critical to public health and safety."

The contest begins October 11, 2023, and ends October 18, 2023, at 5 p.m. How to participate:
