- 2. No candidate shall have his/her name printed on the official ballot nor be qualified to fill the office of Employee Commissioner unless such nominating petitions have been filed in accordance with the regulations, by the above time, and the signatures of <u>not less than</u> fifty (50) active full-time County employees.
- 3. Official nominating petitions may be secured from the Secretary of the Retirement and Deferred Compensation Board located in the Executive Office Building, at the security desk in the main entrance. - 4. Section B of the Oakland County Employees' Retirement System Trustee Election Policy & Procedures provides that no more than one employee member on the Retirement Board shall be from any one County Department, therefore employees of the following departments or divisions will not be eligible for this election:
 - CLERK/REGISTER OF DEEDS
 - SHERIFF'S OFFICE
- 5. All other rules and regulations set forth in the Retirement System's Trustee Election Policy & Procedures shall be strictly enforced unless otherwise determined by the Retirement and Deferred Compensation Board, in its sole discretion.
