GOLF COURSE RULES

GAKLANDCOUNTY PARKS

- 1. Shirts and shoes are required. Non-metal spikes only.
- 2. Starters will decide starting hole, grouping and tee selection.
- 3. Each player must have his or her own clubs and bag for traditional golf or soccer ball for FootGolf.
- 4. Non-golfing walkers, caddies or ball hunters are not permitted.
- 5. Golfers should replace divots, repair all ball marks on greens and rake bunkers.
- 6. All wetlands, natural areas, and ponds are environmentally sensitive. Golfers should refrain from entering. All unplayable balls should be played as a lateral water hazard.
- 7. Play Ready Golf. Pace of play is two hours for nine holes. Players may only play one ball.
- 8. Rainchecks issued due to inclement weather will be prorated based on the number of holes completed that day. Original receipt required to issue raincheck. No raincheck will be issued if already raining when player decided to play.
- 9. Flag colors designate hole location:

Red-Front · White-Middle · Blue-Back

- 10. Orange tees and flags are designated for FootGolf.
- 11. All yardage markers are measured to the center of the green. Red 100 yards · White 150 yards · Blue 200 yards
- 12. Must be at least 18 years of age with valid driver's license to operate a golf cart.
- 13. Lessee is responsible for any damage to golf cart or property.
- 14. Non-golfers may ride on a golf cart, but are subject to a cart rider fee. Non-golfing riders must be 5 years of age or older.
- 15. Youth booster seats or car seats are not allowed on golf carts.
- 16. Maximum 2 riders per golf cart, regardless of age.
- 17. Golf carts, including pull carts, must remain on paths around all tees and greens.
- 18. Twilight golf is a maximum of nine holes.
- 19. Traditional golfers should allow FootGolfers to play through.
- For individual assistance or accommodations, contact the golf course manager.
- Chemicals are applied to the course daily.
