CAMPING

Waterford Oaks is pleased to offer a limited amount of pre-registered campsites that will likely fill up fast. Campsites will be assigned on site at time of arrival on a first come, first served basis once you arrive onsite. Camping will be rustic with a mixture of portable toilets, a portable restroom and onsite restrooms at scheduled times. Showers and additional restrooms will be available at scheduled times at the wave pool. Fires will not be allowed at individual sites, but there will be communal fire pits available.

Fees:

- 72 RV & Trailer Sites (25' x 40') Available - \$150
 - 8 Tent Sites (20' x 20') Available - \$150
- (Includes campsite and parking for the vehicle/RV/trailer all four days. Additional vehicles will be subject to additional parking fees and must park in designated parking areas.)

Onsite Pump Outs

Onsite pump outs will be available from our portable restroom provider July 4-7. Please visit the Operations Tent to be scheduled on your preferred date at time of Check In. A person at least 18 years old that is able to handle payment to the driver must be present at the time of service. If no one is present, no service will be provided.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. **Camping Fees.** Full payment must be paid at the time a reservation is made.
2. **Vehicles.** No more than one vehicle per campsite is permitted. One vehicle included in the cost of reservation.
3. **Transfer.** Reservations cannot be exchanged or transferred to another person/entity or date.
4. **Cancellation.** If notice of a cancellation is received seven (7) or more days prior to the beginning of the reservation, all charges will be refunded. If the notice of cancellation is received less than seven (7) days prior to the beginning of the reservation, the reserving person/entity forfeits the fees paid.
5. **Late Arrivals.** Check-in is only available during the scheduled dates and times.
6. **Damage.** If there is any damage to the campsite, the reserving person is responsible for the cost of repair.
7. **Parks Rules and Regulations.** All Oakland County Park Rules and Regulations must be followed. Please see the OCPR General Information and Regulations booklet for the full set of camping rules. The booklet is available online at oaklandcountyparks.com or at the Operations Tent.
8. **Violation and Fees.** Park staff may remove any person for violation of Park Rules and Regulations. If the person that reserved the campsite is removed from the Park due to violation of Park Rules and Regulations, all fees paid to the park shall be kept by the Park and no fees shall be refunded.
9. For all cancellations call 248.858.0916. Camping reservations cannot be canceled online.





AMENITIES

Waterford Oaks Wave Pool:

Dates and hours will be extended to accommodate the extended holiday weekend and event goers, with the anticipation of the facility being at full capacity and sold out. Advanced purchase of tickets is advised. Tickets are available up to three days in advance online or at the wave pool. Please note: Online ticket sales stop at 2 p.m. for same-day admission; onsite ticket sales stop daily one hour before the wave pool closes.

Admission Fees (per person)

Everyone entering the wave pool must purchase a ticket. Infants ages 0-23 months old need a free child entry ticket. We recommend that no children be unaccompanied in the wave pool. However, those at least 12 years old whose parents/guardians deem them responsible enough to attend without adult supervision will be granted entry.


KEY RULES

1. Make sure you have tickets or call ahead to see if tickets are still available as Waterford Oaks Wave Pool may sell out during the season. Tickets can be purchased ahead of time online or at the waterpark. Once the park is at capacity and tickets are sold out, no more tickets will be available for that day.
2. Keep glass containers and alcohol at home. While Waterford Oaks Wave Pool does allow guests to bring in their own food, glass and alcohol are not allowed in the park.
3. Chairs, toys and sporting equipment are not allowed at the wave pool.
4. Bring proper swimming attire. Street clothes are not allowed in the water.
5. Don't forget sunscreen and be sure to drink plenty of water.
6. Please follow all the park rules and listen to park staff. Read the complete list of Waterford Oaks Wave Pool rules and Oakland County Parks rules.
