



# Can I Vote While In Jail?



Many people believe that if you are detained in jail during an election you cannot vote.

## But this is not true!

You have the full legal right to vote while you are detained in jail so long as you are not currently serving a sentence.

**In fact, you are eligible to register and vote in Michigan *even if*:**

**Your vote and your voice matter!**



- You have a felony record.
- You are on probation, parole, or tether.
- You are awaiting arraignment, trial, or sentencing, regardless of your incarceration status.
- Your housing is unstable.
- You have a disability.
- You do not have a Michigan ID.

**If you are eligible, Michigan law requires that you must be provided with access to vote in jail.** Contact a VAAC voting ambassador at [contact@votingaccessforall.org](mailto:contact@votingaccessforall.org) for the materials you need to vote!
