

On November 5, voters will be asked to consider a proposal to replace and extend the duration of the property tax that supports Oakland County Parks, generating approximately \$24 million a year for investments in parks, trails, recreational areas, and the protection of natural resources throughout Oakland County.



The net .30 increase would equal \$40 or less a year for the average residential taxable value home.
