## **Visionics Receives New \$580K Order From Oakland County CLEMIS Agencies for New Live Scan Systems and Upgrades**

MINNETONKA, Minn. AND JERSEY CITY, N.J.--(BUSINESS WIRE)--June 17, 2002--Visionics Corporation (Nasdaq: [VSNX](#) - [News](#)), the worldwide leader in identification technologies and systems, announced an order from Oakland County CLEMIS for 10 additional Live Scan FingerPrinter CMS (CMS) systems as well as central site equipment and upgrades to the existing live scan system.

With this order, the total number of systems on the Oakland County network is 56 live scans. The order is valued at approximately \$580,000 and is expected to be complete by the end of next quarter.

Dr. Joseph J. Atick, Visionics' Chairman and CEO stated, "Oakland County CLEMIS members continue to benefit from our live scan technology to enhance traditional law enforcement processes, shortening processing cycles and reducing processing errors and ultimately making a tremendous impact on arrests and subject identification. Visionics' commitment to providing cutting-edge technology and customer service has translated into a long list of satisfied and repeat customers, Oakland County CLEMIS being a prime example. Looking ahead, our broadening product line and acquired expertise helps to ensure that we continue to be the most sought-after biometric technology provider to the law enforcement community and beyond."

Oakland County CLEMIS (Courts & Law Enforcement Management Information Systems), a consortium of over 75 law enforcement agencies across five counties in southeastern Michigan which supplies the State with over 33% of all arrest and charge decisions, cited live scan's significant enhancement to its law enforcement efforts as the reason for its new order.

According to Sgt. Kim G. Rossman, Live Scan Project Manager, "By adding the additional ten live scan units along with the Prosecutor's charging system, CLEMIS and Visionics have again enhanced the criminal record building system in the State of Michigan. In addition, the Visionics live scan system continues to prove to be a valuable tool to law enforcement in the identification of suspected offenders".

Visionics' CMS is an integrated live-scan fingerprinting system that captures, prints and transmits fingerprints without the use of ink. The Oakland County CLEMIS Live Scan network integrates Visionics' CMS units, ACMS (AFIS Communications Management System) and Store and Forward system with an Oracle database server in order to provide intelligent data capture, management and transmission. The workstation portion of the system has been tagged "PIMS" (Prosecutor's Information Management System). The Oakland County CLEMIS network reduces subject processing times, enables faster matching of fingerprint records and facilitates electronic submission of charging data to the State.
