IT IS ORDERED that the Defendant in the above-captioned matter shall install an ignition interlock device pursuant to s. 257.625b(8) of the Michigan State statutes and that:		
1) 2) 3)	The Defendant will contact a listed Interlock Service Company. The Defendant shall have the ignition interlock installed within <u>3</u> working days of this Court Order. The Defendant shall provide this court proof of installation within <u>10</u> days of this order.	
4) 5)	The Defendant shall not operate any vehicle not equipped with an approved ignition interlock device. The Defendant shall have the ignition interlock monitored by a listed company. The Defendant shall personally attend all interlock monitoring appointments.	
6)	The Defendant shall be responsible for all costs associated with the installation, use, or damage to the ignition interlock.	
7) 8)	The Defendant shall not adjust, tamper with, alter, or circumvent the ignition interlock, nor shall the Defendant remove the ignition interlock or modify the wiring to the vehicle's ignition system. The defendant will test on the ignition interlock between the times of:	
Special Instructions: A) INTERLOCK DEVICE MUST HAVE A CAMERA B) BRING A PICTURE ID TO THE INTERLOCK AGENCY C) BRING A COPY OF YOUR SENTENCING ORDER OR CONDITIONAL BOND TO THE INTERLOCK AGENCY D) *IF A CONDITION OF BOND, THE INTERLOCK MUST BE A CELLULAR CAPABLE DEVICE.

APPROVED IGNITION INTERLOCK VENDORS LIST

Ignition Interlock: An Interlock system is an alcohol detection device that is connected to your vehicle's ignition system. Each time you start your car, you must first blow into the hand-held part of the unit so that it can measure your breath alcohol concentration (BAC).

Your interlock unit <u>must</u> have a camera, and the threshold <u>must</u> be set to .01. Any time you experience a problem with your interlock (lock out, test positive, continuous requests for a retest), please report to a testing facility and submit to an ETG.

***If you are installing an Interlock Device as a condition of Bond, the unit must have cellular reporting capabilities and it is YOUR responsibility to ensure it does.

<u>IMPORTANT:</u> While using an ignition interlock, please refrain from smoking, brushing your teeth, using mouthwash, eating or drinking for 15 minutes prior to testing. If you test positive on the interlock, and cannot submit a negative test within 15 minutes, it is your responsibility to submit to an ETG test within 12 hours. If you fail to submit to an ETG during that time, the court will assume the positive test was valid.

You have been ordered to refrain from the use of alcohol and alcohol products, while on probation. An alcohol product is defined as anything that contains alcohol, therefore it is your responsibility to read all labels before eating or drinking. Some examples are mouthwash, toothpaste, liquid cold medicine, some liquid capsules and food.
