



CORRUGATED CARDBOARD




Corrugated cardboard has channels to give it added strength. It looks like this:

This only applies to outer cardboard boxes. If it is an inner box, it is fine to keep (unless it looks like it has been wet).

These boxes have no place in a medical facility! They may harbor small insects, bacteria, mold or dust that entered the box in the warehouse or during transit.

Think about all the places that box might have been and all the things it might have come in contact with!
