Sealed bids will be received by the Oakland County, at Oakland County Airports Administration Office, 6500 Patterson Parkway, Waterford, MI 48327 until 1:00pm (local time), on the bid date, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. **ANY BID RECEIVED AFTER THE SPECIFIED TIME WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.**

The proposed Work includes the following: Approximately 8,200 square yards of pavement removal and asphalt overlay, storm drainage improvements and pavement markings.

Bidder Qualifications

Bidders shall submit evidence of qualification meeting the requirements of General Contract Provisions 20-02. Possession by the prime contractor of MDOT prequalification at the time of bidding shall be an acceptable form of evidence. In addition, this project includes Designated Item classifications of Cb. In addition, this project includes Specialty Item Classification EA.

If the prime bidder is not prequalified in the Designated Item classification(s), then it must use a subcontractor that is prequalified in such classification(s). This subcontractor must be designated prior to award of the contract to the confirmed low bidder.

There is a Disadvantage Business Enterprise (DBE) participation goal of 5.0 for this project.
