



Addison Oaks

1480 W. Romeo Road, Leonard More than 20 miles of scenic hiking trails. Park features a solar system trail - closed in winter.

Addison Oaks - East

Located less than .75 mile east of the main park entry on Romeo Road. More than two miles of hiking trails.

Catalpa Oaks

248-464-8953 27705 Greenfield Road, Southfield

A .6 mile aggregate perimeter pathway loops the park.

Groveland Oaks

248-634-9811 14555 Dixie Highway, Holly Nearly 1.5 miles of paved and grassy trails for biking, hiking, in-line skating and strollers.

Highland Oaks

248-858-0916 6555 N. Milford Road, Highland Township Park features 2.5 miles of mowed equestrian-friendly trails.

Independence Oaks

More than 10 miles of challenging natural surface, 2.2-mile River Loop Trail includes a boardwalk and 3.8 miles of paved trails through woods, wetlands, prairie and shoreline.

Independence Oaks - North

10089 Sashabaw Road, Clarkston 1,200-foot-long gravel trail from parking lot to lake.

Lyon Oaks

52251 Pontiac Trail, Wixom Hike 5.7 miles of easy, flat crushed stone trails winding through wet mesic hardwood forests and open meadows.

Orion Oaks

Stroll 12 miles of marked trails.
Nearly one mile of off-leash dog
walking trails are within dog park.

Red Oaks Nature Center

Rose Oaks

248-858-0916 10400 Fish Lake Road, Rose Township Nearly six miles of equestrianfriendly winding gravel and grass trails provide access to lakes and wetlands.

Waterford Oaks

1702 Scott Lake Road, Waterford 1.5-mile trail parallels park roads and surrounds the playground areas. Or hike 1.8 miles through the woods on natural trails.

Free Park Entry

With approval of the 2024 millage request, there is no charge for Oakland County residents to enjoy Oakland County day-use parks and dog parks.

There will continue to be fees for pay to play attractions such as golf courses, Red Oaks Waterpark, campgrounds and Holly Oaks ORV Park.



Guests who are not Oakland County residents are asked to pay a \$12 daily entry fee or a \$50 annual park entry fee to help maintain and improve the parks.
