Oakland County Health Division Communicable Disease Reporting Updates February 27, 2025

- Password for both screens is Report1234!
- Submit 1 report per week Fridays or as early as possible the following week is ideal, but we understand things come up so please try to submit no later than Wednesday following the reporting week. If no report by Wednesdays, we'll have reminder email sent.
- New Users: Send name, title, school/program, and email to cd@oakgov.com to make sure we have them added to our user list and they receive updates. If you need a list of your school's current users, let us know & we'll email to you
- No illnesses reported for a week check the box "No new diseases to report this week"
- Total Number of Illness-Related Absences This Week = number of illness absences each day added for weekly total. E.g., child out for 3 days with flu = 3 absences for week
- Number of each illness (e.g., COVID, Influenza, etc.) = total number kids/cases with each illness (1 kid out for 3 days with COVID = 1 COVID case)
- We understand that you only have as much information as parents/guardians give you on the absence line
 message! Do your best to categorize illnesses according to the options in the form. We don't expect you to
 try and track down details from parents. Please refer to the School Communicable Reporting Instructions
 (slide 7) to help you or give us a call!
- If you have a student or staff member with one of the **individually reported diseases** (Measles, Mumps, Rubella, HiB, Meningitis, Encephalitis, Hepatitis, Tuberculosis, Chickenpox) it is helpful to also give a call at 248-858-1286 so we can follow up with the parent/guardian and provider to confirm diagnoses/lab testing and advise you on any precautions/exclusions, etc. we recommend.
- Some schools/facilities have systems that will pull illness reports for them, and some need to track manually.
 We've attached an excel tracking spreadsheet for you to use during the week if you choose, so that when you go in to complete your weekly report, it's quick for you.
