Eligibility:

The recreation vouchers are only valid for Oakland County residents who must show proof of residency and a U.S. Department of Defense Common Access Card (CAC) or a valid Michigan driver's license with Veteran designation; an Oakland County, state or federal Veteran ID Card (VIC); or form DD214, DD256 or NGB22. Oakland County Gold Star Families need to only show proof of residency. The Department of Defense defines immediate family members as spouses, parents, children, siblings, stepparents, stepchildren, step-siblings, half-siblings, adoptive parents, adopted children and adopted siblings.

Vouchers are non-transferable and are limited to one per eligible person. Vouchers expire Dec. 31, 2025.

Veterans and active military personnel also receive discounts at five golf courses.
