Children's Special Health Care Services (CSHCS) provides family centered and culturally competent assistance to individuals with long term medical needs.

Who Is Eligible?

- Those birth–26 with chronic medical needs
- Covers over 2,700 diagnoses
- Families of all incomes are eligible to apply

What To Expect?

Nurses and other professionals work with families to:

- Assist in paying specialty medical bills, including copays and deductibles
- Connect families to resources and coordinate services
