Changes will be coming for how we bill.

4. New Business

Brief update on UCC program. It has 3 different phases, have been to the board for two phases already. \$10.5 M funded programs.

First phase-Core program is being implemented as we speak. It has gone smoothly on campus and successful should see greater speed at the desktop.

Second Phase-Voice Override (new phone system) in contract negotiations. Should provide reliability with upgrades and updates, start setting up "experience room" to test out what the new phone systems are like, will be set up across from Health in community center building. New handset phones coming for everyone but not required you have one.

July-August: new wireless system upgrades for coverage and public WiFi and have county only WiFi in service locations with secure connections.
