Minutes of the regular meeting of the Drainage Board of the Red Run Drain Drainage District held at the Office of the Macomb County Public Works Commissioner, 21777 Dunham Road, Clinton Township Michigan on the 20th day of July at 10:30 a.m. Eastern Standard Time and via Microsoft Teams.

5. Insurance for the Red Run Drain

Steve Saph of Nichols and Saph presented for consideration the insurance policy prepared by his office. He noted that the proposal was after a full marketing effort and it was recommended to continue with the coverage offered by Argonaut, with a 6.7% increase in premium.

Motion by Miller, supported by Vaara, to approve the insurance policy renewal and pay associated premiums as presented.

6. Freedom Hill.

Ms. Kolinski provided a brief update regarding the Freedom Hill project. She summarized the current status of the Freedom Hill project tasks, indicating that L.J. Construction will be done by July 22nd. She furthered that the residual planting along the trails will be completed this fall and spring of next year. Ms. Kolinski also advised that the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) released their permit for the George W. Kuhn (GWK) Outfall project and a completed design from the Army Corps of Engineers is expected by the end of 2022.

Mr. Baker inquired about the sediment testing along the GWK Headwaters project. Ms. Kolinski stated that the Army Corps of Engineers has reviewed the sediment testing and advised they are not concerned about any of the sediment. The report has been sent to the appropriate staff members for their review.

The Board discussed the potential risk of the lack of proper signage and foliage along the trail site. Due to the nature and position of the trial, it was agreed upon that a not-to-exceed amount of \$10,000 would be appropriate for a design build to restrict access points for public safety.

Motion by Miller, supported by Nash, to authorize a design build for restricting access to the drain for a not-to-exceed amount of \$10,000.
