MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE DRAINAGE BOARD FOR THE OAKLAND-MACOMB INTERCEPTOR DRAIN DRAINAGE DISTRICT

October 21, 2020

Minutes of the regular meeting of the Drainage Board of the Oakland-Macomb Interceptor Drain Drainage District held via GoToMeeting on the 21st day of October at 11:30 a.m. Eastern Standard Time.

PRESENT:

Michael Gregg, Chairperson and Deputy for Gary McDowell, Director of the Michigan Department of Agriculture and Rural Development; Candice Miller, Member and Macomb County Public Works Commissioner; and Jim Nash, Secretary and Oakland County Water Resources Commissioner.

OTHERS PRESENT:

Representing the office of the Macomb County Public Works Commissioner: Brian Baker, Stephen Downing and Emily Engelman. Representing the office of the Oakland County Water Resources Commissioner: Anne Vaara, Steven Korth, Joel Brown, Sid Lockhart, Brian Coburn, Kelsey Cooke and Megan Koss. Others in attendance: Fritz Klingler, FK Engineering; Shawn Phelps, OC Fiscal Services; Brady Harrington, MDARD; Larry Gilbert and Saju Sachidanandan, NTH Consultants; Sal Saputo, Meadowbrook Insurance Group.

1. <u>Call meeting to order</u>.

Chairperson Gregg called the meeting to order at 11:35 a.m.

2. Agenda.

It was indicated that a proposed wastewater services assignment from Brian Baker (under "Other Business") and an additional invoice (Walsh Construction invoice no. 220008 Pre-Con 8) were added to the agenda for Board consideration. Shawn Phelps noted that with the addition of the aforementioned invoice, the total amount of invoices to be approved by the Board was now \$316,304.05. Motion by Miller, supported by Nash, to approve the amended October 21, 2020 agenda as presented.

3. Minutes.

Motion by Nash, supported by Miller, to approve the minutes of the September 16, 2020 meeting.

4. <u>Public Comment.</u> None.

5. <u>Use of Oakland County Photographer and GLWA drone pilot to take construction photos for the NESPS Pumping and Electrical Upgrades Project.</u>

Mr. Brown stated that, per the Drainage District's contract with Walsh Construction, Walsh was required to obtain 10 professional construction photos per month of the jobsite. The photographs are to demonstrate the progress taken toward the effort at hand. Mr. Brown noted that, of the many options were explored, the most cost-effective option was to utilize the Oakland County photographer and to partner with GLWA for the use of their drone.

Motion by Nash, supported by Miller, to approve the use of an Oakland County photographer and GLWA pilot with drone to take project progress construction photos for a not-to-exceed amount of \$29,300.

Discussion of Project Budget Summary and present for approval the Drainage District
 entering into a contract with Marra Construction for the NI-EA Rehabilitation Project.
 Mr. Brown provided an overview of the project budget summary. He indicated that all the
 items on the October 21, 2020 agenda were within the project budget.

As to the contract for the NI-EA Rehabilitation Project, Mr. Brown indicated that four bids were received, with Marra Services Inc. coming in at the lowest. NTH reviewed all the bids and believed Marra had the relevant experience and resources to complete the job. Discussion ensued regarding Marra's lack of experience lining systems 72 inches or greater in diameter and their overall ability to handle the project. Both Mr. Klinger and Mr. Sachidanandan spoke to Marra's professionalism and work product with other unrelated projects.

Motion by Nash, supported by Miller, to award the NI-EA Contact No.1 PCI-4 Rehabilitation Project Contract to Marra Services, Inc., permit the OMIDDD Secretary to sign the agreement by December 16, 2020 and issue a Notice to Proceed by January 4, 2020.

7. <u>Lockout-Tagout procedure discussion</u>.

Mr. Brown provided an update and overview of the current state of the lockout-tagout procedure, noting that liability aspects of the aforementioned need to be addressed in relation to the contractor and METCO. It was also indicated that there was no current operational agreement between the Macomb Interceptor Drain Drainage District and the Drainage District. Mr. Lockhart stated a delay with the Doetsch project the past several months was attributable to the unsettled nature of the lockout-tagout procedure.

Mr. Downing stressed the importance of a mutual effort between the relevant drainage districts in drafting the lockout-tagout procedure memo. Discussion ensued regarding the

prior efforts to draft a memo and concerns of the parties' interests. It was mutually agreed that it was in the best interest of the Drainage District to work together to solidify the relevant procedure and corresponding documents.

8. Present for approval the guaranteed maximum price amendment with Walsh Construction for the NESPS Pumping and Electrical Upgrades Project.

Mr. Brown provided an overview of the NESPS Pumping and Electrical and CS-9 Gate Installation Projects in terms of cost and completion. The Drainage District and Walsh agreed to the following contractual completion dates as recommended by the design team: NESPS Pumping and Electrical Upgrades substantial completion by March 28, 2023 and final completion by June 22, 2023; CS-9 Gate Installation substantial completion by June 22, 2021 and final completion by July 24, 2021.

It was moved by Miller, supported by Nash, to approve the attached Guaranteed Maximum Price Amendment (as attached); authorize the OMIDDD Secretary to execute the Amendment on behalf of the Drainage District for the NESPS Pumping and Electrical Upgrades Project in the amount of \$40,856,627.46 and for the CS-9 Gate Installation Project in the amount of \$3,251,117.72 (resulting in a net increase to Walsh's contract in the amount of \$27,653,150.73); and approve the contractual completion dates as presented.

 Amendment, was April 18, 2020, with Final Completion of August 28, 2020. The actual Final
 Completion date will be delayed due to COVID-19 issues (travel restrictions, etc.) and the addition
 of extra work items commencing late in the project but is expected to be complete by end of
 November 2020.
- BTF Acclimation, Start-up and Testing: Currently completed with the facility in normal operating mode.
- HVAC Improvements: Substantial Completion was June 28, 2020; now nearing final completion, less minor punch list issues.

Status of Major Project Tasks:

- All major work is complete including the installation of the biotrickling filter (BTF), odor control
 fans, odorous air ducting, electrical and controls wiring installation, wet well crane painting, all
 HVAC components, and related components for all these items have been completed. The system
 is performing as anticipated. Requested extra work and punch list items remain outstanding
 related to the biotrickling filter and were completed during the first week of November 2020.
- The addition of a partial crane roof shelter has been completed. Cleaning and painting of the wet well hatch covers will occur in the immediate future under favorable weather conditions.
- Final adjusting activities remain for air balancing of the wet well HVAC system, which are expected to be completed in early November 2020.
- All dry well HVAC components have been installed including power and controls and are now
 operational. HVAC control system components including the master control panel, gas detection
 panel, and associated strobes, beacons, instruments, and devices have arrived on site and all have
 been installed. These components have been integrated into one fully functioning HVAC control
 system (including SCADA) and final startup and commissioning is complete; however, final
 adjustments remain to complete system air balancing inside the dry well and confirm fully
 acceptable operation.

Site grading for the BTF pad and adjacent areas have been completed; grade has been set and hydroseeding has been completed and turf growth established, with final adjustments to take place during punch list activities. Final aggregate base and concrete paving work will be deleted from the odor/corrosion control project and added to the upcoming pump and electrical rehabilitation project. Fall re-seeding of the vegetated areas surrounding the BioFilter equipment pad has taken place to ensure full turf establishment in Spring 2021.



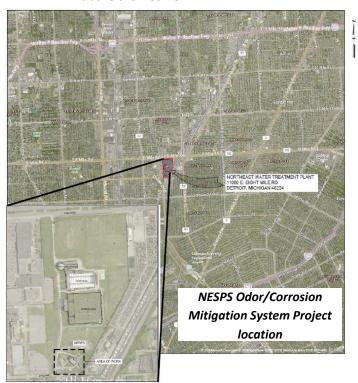

Advance modifications to facilitate the "Emergency Contingency Plan" are underway to allow pumping in the event of total power loss at NESPS or other catastrophic failure in the system:

- Drawings for modifications to accommodate upstream emergency pumping are complete; contractor selected, start of work pending.
- Plan to energize OMID Pump 4 in event of total power loss is complete; A demonstration of the portable generator was completed previously and start of work is pending.
- Advanced emergency plan document to include pumping details and traffic control from pump out locations has been reviewed by technical team; awaiting completion of manhole and electrical modifications to finalize the document.

Additional work being performed under Metco Maintenance Contract for NESPS:

- Mechanical and Electrical corrective/preventative maintenance schedules continue to proceed without problem. Shutdown coordination with GLWA Operations for such tasks is working well.
- Monthly Maintenance Contractor meeting held. General maintenance topics discussed.
- Working with GLWA Systems Control to develop a more balanced approach to Sanitary Pump run time.
- Coordination between GLWA, MIDDD, NESPS Odor/Corrosion Control Project (Bio Filter) has not affected station operations nor hindered performance or abilities to meet demands.

Overall Station Performance Report:

- Sanitary Pumps #1, #2, #4, and #6 ready for duty. (640 CFS Capacity).
- Sanitary Pump #5 Motor exciter repaired, installed, and tested in a well-coordinated effort involving GLWA and MCE. Pump #5 ready for duty. The damaged exciter is to be refurbished and placed in stock inventory.
- Service Elevator rehabilitation has been completed, with final inspection pending.
- 25 ton Indoor Crane Bi-Annual inspections completed. Report on file. The crane is currently out of service (hoist inoperable) due to IO board failure. Repair is scheduled for the week of November 9, 2020. A meeting was held October 25, 2020 with Kone Crane and OMID due to repeated hoist outages. It was determined that age is likely a factor and that a complete electrical modification would restore long term operability. An inspection/ investigation scheduled and a proposal on an electrical/structural overhaul is anticipated. Additionally, the contractor was asked to propose cost for new indoor crane.

- Failed wet-well isolation knife gates have been removed and replaced. Dewatering unit has been removed and taken off site for repair. This equipment is expected to be returned to service on December 1, 2020.
- Ragging (barscreens) and sediment accumulations have been identified as an
 operational issue and discussed with the OMID team. Last cleaning 2018. Wet well
 cleaning proposal in review.
- Stand-by Generator Programmable Logic Controller (PLC) rehabilitation is progressing.
 Baseline testing has been completed and hardware received. Start date scheduled for December 1, 2020
- Stand-by Generator Diesel Tank and Fuel Line rehab project is underway as of October 14, 2020. Tank exterior restorations are complete (primer/paint, new placards, etc.)
 Fuel line modifications are scheduled for completion November 9, 2020. Final overall completion date is set for November 20, 2020.
- PH and H₂s levels at BioFilter are monitored and recorded daily. PH feedback is indicative of an active Bio removal rate per Bio Air. Readings are reported to Bio-Air regularly and a follow-up visit by Bio Air representative is currently being planned. No odor complaints have been received since October 8, 2020.
- Debris (ragging) starting to impact flow through the bar-screens. De-ragging operations took place Sept 21st and Oct 7th. More work is needed to complete the cleaning operation
- The motor operator for the State Fair entrance gate has been replaced due to end of life conditions of existing gate.
- Knox Box emergency entry safety equipment has been received and is ready to be installed (Detroit Fire Department approved and regulated).
- NEXGEN asset management project continues without issues. Asset inventory and data collection continues without issues.
- Overall general housekeeping tasks are in order.
- Overall groundskeeping tasks are also in order.

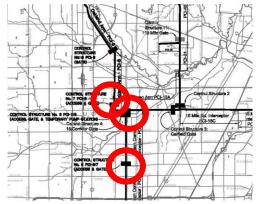
