## 52<sup>ND</sup> DISTRICT COURT ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER **2002-20**

## UNSCHEDULED COURT CLOSING DUE TO WEATHER EMERGENCY Rescinds Administrative Order 1999-04

## IT IS ORDERED:

The Local Administrative Order is issued pursuant to Michigan Supreme Court Administrative Order 1998-5 and after consultation with the Oakland County Executive to provide for procedures for suspension of court operations and closure of court facilities due to weather emergencies. It is the court's intent to ensure that decisions regarding suspension of court operations are consistent with decisions made regarding Oakland County operations to the extent possible without undue disruption of service to litigants.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Chief Judge of the 52<sup>nd</sup> District Court will consult with the Oakland County Executive to determine if a weather emergency will result in a decision to close the facility where the court is located. Court facilities will not close without the approval of the Oakland County Executive and the Chief Judge of the 52<sup>nd</sup> District Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the decision to close the court will be announced by the Chief Judge to court employees and local law enforcement by a means to reasonable assure notice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that public notice will be made by posting a notice at all court entrances and providing announcement over local radio and/or television stations.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the County of Oakland declares a weather emergency and closes the facility where the court is located, court employees will charge time off in a manner consistent with the way the County of Oakland treats its employees for that closure.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the 52<sup>nd</sup> District Court adopts the policy of the County of Oakland regarding closure due to weather that is attached.
