ORDER GOVERNING OAKLAND COUNTY PROBATE COURT EMPLOYEES

ELECTED OFFICE

IT APPEARING TO THE COURT that pursuant to Michigan Court Rule 8.112(B) that a trial court may issue administrative orders governing internal court management,

IT FURTHER APPEARING that in order to assure that Oakland County Probate Court employees are not placed in a position of conflict of interest within their Court; and

IN ORDER to prevent and to remove any implication of impropriety; and

IN ORDER to assure the continuation of the Court's business in a timely, appropriate and orderly manner; and

IN ORDER to maintain the dignity of the Court by limiting the conduct of political activity within the Court which will have a

disruptive effect on service to the public;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that any Oakland County Probate Court employee, excluding an incumbent Judge, who seeks to hold a County or State elected position shall resign from their position or secure a leave of absence for the period during which they are a candidate for office.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that such leave of absence shall be effective upon the employee's filing for declaration of candidacy for the office sought. The leave of absence shall be with pay up to the amount of accrued annual leave and personal leave and shall otherwise be without pay for the duration of said employee's candidacy for office.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order has immediate effect and is to remain in full force and effect until the further order of this Court.
