These are <u>some</u> of the procedural changes that are **effective immediately**; the court continues to sort out additional details. The court rule amendments can be viewed at the SCAO website at: http://courts.michigan.gov (click on "Court Rules, proposed and recently adopted")

Death certificates are required to start every decedent estate.

"Alternative documentation" may be accepted if a death certificate is not available (a letter from the morgue, hospital or funeral home, or an obituary from a newspaper would be acceptable).

The <u>inventory fee calculation</u> now allows for deductions for secured loans on property (real or personal). We will deduct the balance owing on the loan. See November 2006 Notice: Calculation of Inventory Fees (aka Gross Estate Fees) Changed at: http://www.oakgov.com/probate/assets/docs/New

<u>Inventories on conservatorships</u> must list all property the protected person owns jointly or in common with others, indicating the type of ownership. The name(s) of the other owner(s) is/are not required.

<u>Conservatorship accounts</u> must be served on all interested persons annually, and a proof of service must be filed along with the account.

<u>Conservators of minors</u> must file an **initial verification** of funds on deposit (showing the establishment of a restricted account) **within 14 days** of qualification, as well as an **annual verification with a copy of the financial institution statement attached**, and the annual account.

At the time the account is filed, <u>all conservators</u> must present a copy of the **financial institution statement** for all liquid assets (anything except real or personal property) **dated within 30 days** after the end of the accounting period.

<u>Conservators petitioning for the sale of real estate</u> must attach a copy of the most recent assessor statement or tax statement showing the state equalized value.
