

- 2. Multi-purpose field, tot-lot (Phase II).
- 3. Rustic picnic shelter and stone fireplace, restrooms (Phase II).
- 4. Parking for 75 cars (Phase II).

C. Day/Youth Outdoor **Education Area**

- 1. Council ring/Amphitheater.
- 2. Trail link to Moose Tree Nature Preserve.
- 3. Restroom (Phase II).
- 4. Nature Preserve Area.






