The number of reported cases increased by 909 cases. The average number of tests per day increased by 116 tests. Percent positivity increased 1.75% over the last 28 days and increased 2.39% over the last 7 days. Deaths increased by 0.14%. The percentage of cases hospitalized increased by .07%. There was an increase in cases observed for all age groups. Healthcare capacity in many places is still at or nearing capacity with a range of 46-99%. Testing, tracing, containment and infrastructure remain stable.
